Processing of personal data in Saferoad

When you use our website or in other ways are in contact with us, for instance by the purchase of our products or services, Saferoad will collect and process your personal data in line with the Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulations. Below you will find information regarding which type of personal data that is being collected, the reasons for and purposes of why we collect the data and your rights regarding the processing of your personal data.

1. The purposes of our data collection and what types of data we collect

We collect and process your personal data for various purposes depending on who you are and how we get in touch with you. We collect the following personal data for the purposes mentioned below:

- 1. Respond to incoming enquiries: Name, telephone number, e-mail address and other personal data collected in connection with the enquiry. The processing purpose is based on the legitimate commercial interest of helping you with your enquiry.
- 2. The recruitment of new vacancies and positions: CV, applications, references and attestations. The processing of data is based on your given consent.
- 3. In order to obtain information regarding the use of our web pages we use cookies. You about cookies and which cookies we can read more use here. http://www.saferoad.co.uk/cookie-policy/. The processing of cookies is based on the commercial interest of adjusting our web pages for the benefit of users. We ensure your data protection by only using this information for statistical purposes. In this statistic it is not possible to identify you as an individual. We delete collected personal data on a daily basis.

2. Disclosure of personal data to others

We do not give out or disclose your personal data to others unless there is a legal obligation for such disclosure. Examples as to basis for disclosure could typically be a contract with you or legal basis in the law instructing us to provide out the information. Saferoad uses data processors to collect, store

or in other way process data on our behalf. In such cases we have concluded data processing agreements to ensure the information security in all segments of the data processing. As of today, we use the following data processors:

• Saferoad ASA. Saferoad is part of the Saferoad Group. Personal data is being processed for the purpose of handling orders and delivering services to our customers. The processing of personal data is being carried out in the computer systems of the Saferoad Group.

All processing of data carried out by us within the EU / EEA area, is done in line with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).

3. Storage period

We only store your personal data for as long as necessary for the purpose the data was collected for. This means for instance that personal data collection based on your consent will be deleted if you withdraw your consent. Personal data we process in the performance of a contract with you will be deleted when the contract is implemented and all obligations pursuant to the contract have been implemented.

4. Your rights when we process your personal data

You have the right to obtain access to, correction and deletion of your personal data processed by us. You also have the right to obtain restriction of processing, direct objection to the processing and obtain the right to data portability.
