- Establishing lines and levels on-site
- Receiving, handling and storing fencing materials on-site
- The preparation and operation of handheld power tools and attachments
- The reinstatement of defective fencing
- The safe preparation and formation of foundations for fencing and/or vehicle restraint systems
- The safe placement and fixing of fence posts and/or vehicle restraint systems.
- The safe placement and fixing of fencing components and/or vehicle restraint systems.
- The construction of foundations or anchorage for fence installation.

The assessment will consist of portfolio evidence provided by the learner which could include, video and audio evidence, witness statements, practical observations and naturally occurring work-based evidence such as permits, Risk Assessments and Method Statements as well as recognition of prior learning undertaken by the learner.
