The finer details

The amount of instruction you will require will depend largely upon your previous experience and sessions will be adapted to meet your needs.

- Theory Assessment

If learners are successful in meeting the required assessment standard, you will be awarded a certificate of competence and be able to apply for a first green Fencing Industry Skills Scheme (FISS) card or renew your current Fencing Industry Skills Scheme/Construction Skills Certification Scheme (FISS/CSCS) green (labourer) and blue (installer) cards.
